### **ALL STUDENTS:**

Students must purchase their books. **Please make sure to purchase the specific edition listed of each text.** All books should be obtained as soon as possible, ideally by the beginning of the school year. Students should allot the appropriate amount of time for a book shipment to arrive and should not rely on last-minute purchases at local bookstores.

**Texts highlighted in red will be provided by the teacher and do not need to be purchased.**

### **SUMMER READING**

Please note that **AP, IB, and Honors courses include a summer reading text.** Students enrolled in those courses are expected to have read the assigned text prior to the start of the school year and will need a physical copy of the text in class. Students should expect that their summer reading will either be evaluated through an in-class assessment or that the text will be integrated directly into the course curriculum. All other courses do not require summer reading.

### **NEW STUDENTS:**

**If you are considering enrolling in an AP, IB, or Honors course, please select the summer reading text for what you anticipate will most likely be your course.** For instance, if you are entering grade 11 but you are uncertain whether you will take Honors World Literature or Honors Asian Literature, choose the one that is most likely. When classes begin, your teachers will arrange assessment of the summer text you read as needed. If possible, get the correct edition of the summer reading text; however, teachers can be flexible with text editions for new students. Unless you are entering Grade 9, most students will not know their English class placement until school begins in August—please wait until you know what course you are taking before purchasing the remaining books for the year.

### **KINDLES/E-READERS**

Unless specifically noted on a particular course page, physical copies of all texts are required. If a course permits digital copies of any texts, those must be read on an e-reader such as a Kindle—students are not permitted to use e-texts on their laptops, tablets, or phones in the classroom.

### **STUDENTS with TWO ENGLISH COURSES:**

Students who have two English classes with summer reading (AP, IB, Honors) must read the summer texts for both courses.





