



- or if unsure you have an account.


# When prompted,


- 1. enter your full @tas.edu.tw email address,
- 2. be careful not to enter the wrong (default/saved) login,
- 3. hit the Continue Button.

- 4. On the next screen, choose your own password,
- 5. hit the Log In Button.


#### Note:

The option to "Login without a password" should not be used for a first-time login or to renew your account.





# When Prompted to verify your email,




1. open your email and find the confirmation link then, either

- right-click and copy the link or
- select and copy the link,







open any browser, (not Chrome)



3. paste the link onto your browser's address (URL) field and click enter.
